AND WHEREAS, the party of the first part and the second part are executing the said Memorandum of Understanding for availing the beneficial objective of Compulsory Rotating Internship training of undergraduates of MBBS course of BMCRI, WHEREAS the parties now wish to put on record the terms and conditions of this agreement in writing which appear hereinafter.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS UNDER

- 1. Cooperation and promotion of education and training in Ayurveda stream for House surgeons of the first Party.
- 2. The house surgeons of first Party will be permitted to use the clinical material and facilities related to Ayurveda, in the hospital attached to second party, for education and training purpose as mandated National Medical council (NMC) without any charges applicable to the interns.
- 3. The duration of postings shall be in accordance with internship guidelines of NMC.
- 4. The first party shall be responsible for provision of stipend to the house surgeons during the period of this posting.
- 5. The second party shall be responsible for providing training, supervise the same, and monitor attendance during this posting. The mentor or other

person assigned by head of the second party institution shall provide an attendance statement of each batch of house surgeons at the completion of the posting.

- 6. Both parties agree to hold in confidence all information / data designated by them as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of the Memorandum of Understanding and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party. The above confidentiality clause under this Memorandum of Understanding excludes the information / data possessed by either party before entering into this Memorandum of Understanding or independently developed and for information already available through public domain.
- 7. This Memorandum of Understanding will be valid for 10 (TEN) years from the effective date of endorsement and execution of the said understanding. .




